Record of membership meeting of NGO



NGO has declared

1. NGO decided that the main organization continues under the statutes.
The Head of NGO can exercise the (power of) veto. The membership meetings can exercise the (power of) veto to the low-level sections of NGO. The demands of quality of next members continues under the statutes of NGO.
2. For the reason of deciding, NGO separates to two sections – domestic proceedings and international proceedings.
3. Section of International proceedings separates two low-level sections- TOP-management and Guidance.
4. Section of TOP-management decides and is responsible for economy and management of NGO.
5. Section is responsible decides and is responsible for quality of work of NGO.

6. In the Section of International proceedings, NGO decides about cases before international institutions.
7. NGO decided that NGO will submit applications neither the European Court of Human Rights, nor NGO will submit applications and requests before the other international institutions particularly before the United Nations, the Organization for Security and Co-operation in Europe, the European Union and the others international institutions.
8. By the investigations of violations of human rights and international conventions, NGO investigates all circumstances of this violation and therefore NGO turns to the injured states. It means the state in which name was declared any decision against the damaged citizen, in the name of the international institution.
